<html> <p>etckeeper is a collection of tools to let

/etc

be stored in a git, mercurial, bazaar or darcs repository. This lets you use git to review or revert changes that were made to

/etc

. Or even push the repository elsewhere for backups or cherry-picking configuration changes.</p>
<p>It hooks into package managers like apt to automatically commit changes made to /etc during package upgrades. It tracks file metadata that git does not normally support, but that is important for /etc, such as the permissions of

/etc/shadow
